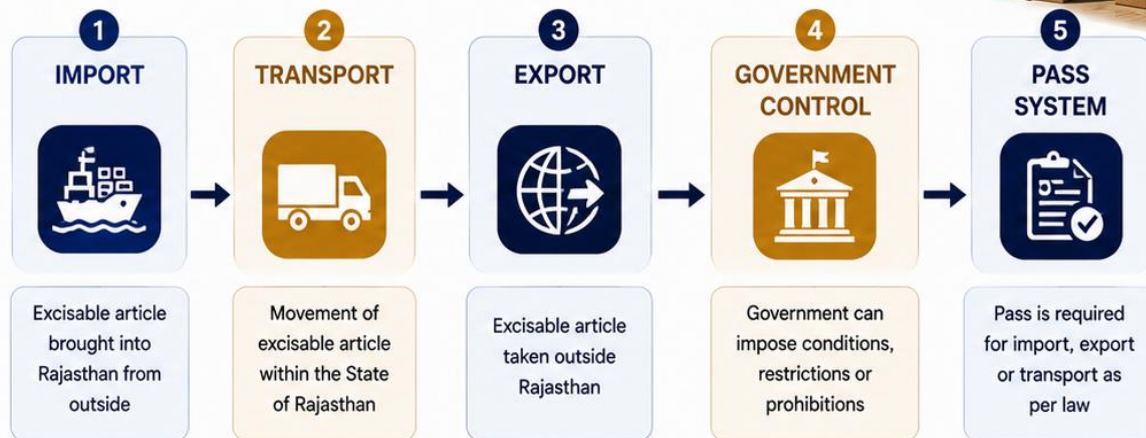

Every movement of an excisable article is under **statutory control**



“No excisable article moves freely.
Every movement is regulated.”



KEY TAKEAWAY: The Act regulates the entire journey of an excisable article from its entry to exit.



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IMPORT vs EXPORT vs TRANSPORT

SECTIONS 11 & 12



SECTION 11 – IMPORT OF EXCISABLE ARTICLE

No excisable article shall be **imported** unless:

1



The State Government has given **permission**, either general or special, for its import.

2



Such conditions (if any) as the **State Government** impose, have been satisfied.

3



The duty (if any) imposed under **Section 28** has been paid or a **bond** has been executed for the payment thereof.



SECTION 12 – EXPORT & TRANSPORT OF EXCISABLE ARTICLE

No excisable article shall be **exported** unless:

1



The duty (if any) imposed under **Section 28** has been paid or a **bond** has been executed for the payment thereof.

2



Such conditions (if any) as the **State Government** may impose, have been satisfied.



KEY DIFFERENCE



IMPORT requires **GOVERNMENT PERMISSION**.



EXPORT (and Transport) **DOES NOT** require **GOVERNMENT PERMISSION**.



EXAM TRAP

Always check the first condition!

Import needs Government Permission.

Export does not.

KEY TAKEAWAY

Import, Export and Transport of excisable articles are permitted only after compliance with **statutory requirements**.



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GOVERNMENT POWER TO RESTRICT MOVEMENT (SECTION 13)



The State Government may, by **notification** in the **Official Gazette**:

- a**



PROHIBIT THE IMPORT
of any excisable article
into the territories to which
this Act extends or any part
thereof.
- OR**
- b**



PROHIBIT THE EXPORT
of any excisable article
from the territories to which
this Act extends or any part
thereof.
- OR**
- c**



PROHIBIT THE TRANSPORT
of any excisable article
within the territories to
which this Act extends.



KEY FEATURES

- ✓ Power is exercised **ONLY** by **notification** in the **Official Gazette**.
- ✓ Applies to **whole State** or **any part** thereof.
- ✓ Covers **Import, Export** and **Transport**.
- ✓ It is a **prohibition** power, not a dispensing power.

EXAM TRAP

Government cannot prohibit movement without issuing a **notification in the Official Gazette**. Any such order without notification is **ultra vires**.



KEY TAKEAWAY: The State Government holds the key to **regulate** the movement of excisable articles through **notification**.



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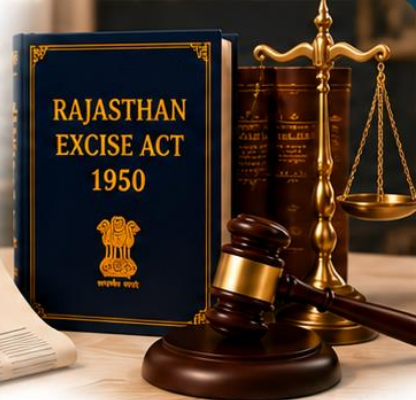
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PASS SYSTEM

(SECTION 14)



No excisable article **exceeding such quantity** as prescribed by the State Government shall be imported, exported or transported **except under a pass**.

WHEN IS A PASS REQUIRED?



Is the quantity of excisable article within the limit prescribed by the State Government?

YES



No Pass Required

NO



Pass Required

Must be under a pass issued u/s 15

EXCEPTIONS

Unless the State Government otherwise directs, **no pass shall be required** for transport of any excisable article or intoxicating drug exported under a pass issued by an authorised officer from any place **beyond the limits** of those parts of Rajasthan to which this Act extends to **any other place beyond the said limits**.



KEY POINTS

- Pass is **mandatory** once quantity exceeds prescribed limit.
- Applies to **Import, Export** and **Transport**.
- Limit is prescribed by notification in the **Official Gazette**.
- Exception available for transport **beyond Rajasthan** under export pass.



EXAM TRAP

If quantity is **within limit** — No Pass.
If quantity **exceeds limit** — **Pass is compulsory**.

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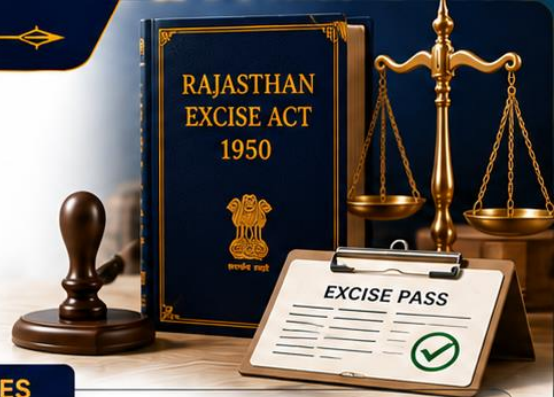


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GRANT OF PASSES

(SECTION 15)



Passes for the import, export or transport of excisable article may be granted by the **authorities mentioned below**, subject to **restrictions imposed by the State Government** from time to time.

WHO CAN GRANT PASSES?



All passes are granted **subject to restrictions** imposed by the State Government.

TYPES OF PASSES

Such passes may be of either of the following kinds:



1. GENERAL PASS

- ✓ Issued for **definite periods**.
- ✓ Allowed for **specified kinds** of articles or drugs.
- ✓ Valid for **repeated** transactions within the conditions.



Think: **Standing Permission**



2. SPECIAL PASS

- ✓ Issued for **specified occasions** or **particular consignments** only.
- ✓ One-time or single transaction based.
- ✓ Not valid for any other occasion or consignment.



Think: **One-time Permission**



KEY TAKEAWAY:

Passes are the **legal travel documents** for excisable articles. Without pass (where required), movement is illegal.



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
